All Meetings Were With Verizon Washington, D.C. Counsel and Local Counsel

| December 19, 2007 | Verizon files Form 100 |
| March 10, 2008 | After considerable drafting and review with the Board, and others, the Board issued the official "Issuing Authority Report" to Verizon. |
| April 16, 2008 | Verizon forwarded an "Amended Application for Cable Television License in Milford". <ul style="list-style-type: none">• In the interim staff drafted reviews of the differences between the Milford version and the Verizon version circulated between the Town and Verizon. |
| June 2, 2008 | First meeting at the Milford Town Hall with Verizon representatives to discuss differences.

Revisions developed and exchanged. |
| June 23, 2008 | Second meeting with Verizon representatives to further review differences between the competing license versions. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Further revisions considered and exchanged. |
| August 7, 2008 | Meeting at Milford Town Hall with Verizon representatives where Verizon relied upon provisions of the Federal Law to assert its positions on outstanding issues. |
| August 14, 2008 | Meeting at Milford Town Hall. Milford presented detailed license re-draft incorporating most of the demands of Verizon as a result of the Milford Selectmen's Meeting on August 11 th . <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Verizon representatives reacted positively with the town's response. Wanted time to review to see if they had any further concerns indicating they would get back to us shortly.• No further response from Verizon until November of 2008 where they asked for an electronic version of what had |

been provided in August. That version was forwarded to Verizon on November 7, 2008.

- January 8, 2009 Email from Counsel for Verizon to G. Moody requesting a date to set up a negotiation session.
- January 22, 2009 Meeting with Counsels for Verizon to discuss license.
- January 28, 2009 Email from G. Moody to Counsel for Verizon requesting a time on the next date when we could speak at length as to changes Verizon sought.
- January 28 2009 Counsel for Verizon responds indicating 11:00 A.M. to speak on the 29th of January.
- February 9, 2009 1:00 meeting with Counsels for Verizon.
- February 10, 2009 Letter from G. Moody to Counsel for Verizon referring to the meeting on January 22nd at which time we went over the recent license redraft prepared by Verizon's Counsel and further reference to the meeting on February 9th indicating that I presented them with a new draft of a final license with significant revisions indicating that we agreed at the conclusion of the meeting that Verizon would further review the draft and respond by telephone in sufficient time so that the parties might be close to an agreement by the next Selectmen's Meeting.
- March 23, 2009 Email from Counsel for Verizon to Gerry Moody referring to our phone conversation of February 20th wherein he indicated he was seeking to obtain further information. He indicates he now has the further information and will provide a revised license later this week.
- March 31, 2009 Email from Counsel for Verizon forwarding a revised draft license. He requests to schedule a conference call to discuss the revised license after I have an opportunity to review it.
- April 3, 2009 Response of Gerry Moody to Counsel for Verizon regarding a prior email indicating the differences in the license what Milford insists upon, and indications that we are at an endpoint.
- June 11, 2009 Email from Gerry Moody to Counsels for Verizon pointing out that it has been several months since I have heard and asking what their intentions are. With reference to the fact that at the last meeting I was told I would hear from them "shortly".

June 24, 2009

Email to Counsels for Verizon informing them that I would be on vacation from July 3 – July 14; telling them I haven't heard from them since the conference call in April and asking if they have any reaction to our discussions of April.
